
A continuation of The Bridge, our fall programming will focus on what is ahead... we are almost across the bridge and crossing over into this new and changed world.

Midweek Missions – Session 2 October 28 to November 18


In the second Midweek Missions unit, we will put together our annual Thanksgiving Baskets for Gladden Community House families. This unit will go from October 28 to November 18.

On Wednesdays at 4:30 pm, the Midweek Missions video lesson for that week's project will be shared on the main <u>First Community Facebook page</u>.

Most weeks, children can watch the video and do the project when it is convenient for them. One Wednesday during the 4-week unit, Julie Richards will meet via Zoom for 30 minutes with the kids from specific grade levels to check in and do a project together.

We ask families to register every year to ensure we have the most updated information for your child. Registration allows us to prepare materials, have your emergency contact information, and be aware of any medical issues your child might have. Registration also ensures we can keep you informed about changes in our programming and about upcoming special events.
