



Health and Safety Policy

Thank you for observing these guidelines when visiting any of our locations.

1 PLEASE DO NOT COME TO CHURCH IF:

- You or any others in your household are experiencing (or have in the last 14 days) any symptoms associated with COVID-19 such as: cough, shortness of breath, chills, loss of taste or smell, body aches and difficulty breathing, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, headache, or diarrhea.
- You or any others in your household had a fever of 100.4°F or higher within the past 14 days.
- You or any others in your household have another household member (or another close contact) who is experiencing (or has experienced in the past 14 days) symptoms associated with COVID-19.
- You or any others in your household have been exposed to or diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days.
- You or any others in your household are currently subject to a mandatory quarantine pursuant to local, state, and federal health authorities.

We encourage you to join us virtually if you do not meet the above criteria.

2 BEFORE YOU ENTER THE CHURCH (while still in your car)

- Put on your face mask. Please wear your face mask the entire time you are in the church premises, making sure it completely covers your nose and mouth.
- Use hand sanitizer.

3 OBSERVE “SOCIAL DISTANCING” GUIDELINES

- At least 6-feet away from others at all times while you are on church property.
- Do not touch anyone outside of those who came with you.

4 ARRIVAL PROCEDURES:

- You will be escorted into the Sanctuary and seated beginning at the front of the Sanctuary in the closest available space. Please stay in your designated seat. Once you are seated, please do not allow anyone other than your accompanying family or guests to join you.
- Make sure you are seated six feet away from other parties from all sides.

5 EXITING PROCEDURES:

- We employ recessional exiting from the worship space, one row at a time starting in the back, as directed by the ushers.
- Once you have exited the worship space, please do NOT linger, and promptly exit the building. We also ask any congregating in the parking lot be limited to groups of less than 10 while observing social distancing.
