### Governing Board Key Takeaways June 2021

- The Governing Board adopted the strategic initiatives as presented by the Strategic Planning Team. These initiatives will be rolled out to the congregation shortly. Watch the emails and website for details.
- The Governing Board received the annual report from the First Community Foundation. The Foundation earned 10.71% in 2020 and distributed almost \$650k in grants to First Community and its missions. The Foundation is approaching \$10m in assets.
- 3. The Church continues to experience solid financial performance. Pledge revenue continues to be above budget while expenses are running below budget. With summer camp in operation and some unexpected repairs at all campuses, expenses will most likely be above budget in June. We ask that members try to keep their pledge current during the summer.
- 4. The Finance Committee presented a report on changes to our donor accounting. The changes will re-enforce donor intent for all restricted gifts, is consistent with generally accepted accounting principles and employs best practices. The new procedures will be effective July 1<sup>st</sup>.

Glen Miles gave the closing prayer. Cydney Philbin adjourned the meeting at 8:58 pm.







# 10 Year Perspective







### **Updated COVID Ministry Plan**

The details listed below will go into effect on Wednesday, June 2 and are subject to change based on the most current CDC and Ohio Department of Health guidelines.

### **1 PUBLIC WORSHIP**

- Face masks are no longer required if fully vaccinated.
- No longer need to RSVP for a worship service.
- Social distancing of 6' between households is at discretion of individuals, if vaccinated.
- Individuals who have heightened health concerns, are at risk or with unvaccinated children and youth are encouraged to continue to be masked and practice social distancing.

### 2 INDOOR PROGRAMMING (Sunday school, small groups, other events)

- Face masks are no longer required if all participants are fully vaccinated. If a participant is unvaccinated, all participants should consider being masked.

### Report of The Burkhart Center to the Governing Board of First Community

### Shah Hasan June 18, 2021

This report is based on my personal observation and engagement with the inspiring leaders of the FC communities of people known as Spiritual Searchers – (no longer a traditional committee but rather an experiential and idea generation group), the Adult Learning Council, and other educational projects operating under the rubric of The Burkhart Center. In the past several months all programming in these areas have been collectively unified around The Burkhart Center (TBC), led by a "Steering Committee," that is in turn led by Chair Rose Konrath and Vice Chair Abbey Jo Griffith, and guided by the Rev. David Hett, who serves in the role of the chief educational program leader – or Dean – of The Burkhart Center.

The Burkhart Center (TBC) has had many recent accomplishments. Despite the pandemic, the programming generated by the various subcommunities of TBC in the past several months have been varied, frequent, and encouraging. Programming that has included major speakers, lecture series, book discussions, and facilitated topical conversations – all initiated, fund-raised, and coordinated by peer leaders working with David Hett. Recent programs have generated increasing participation by new people who join because of their particular interest in the programming. In addition to the Father Gregory Boyle virtual event, David Hett recently led a multi-part Sermon on the Mount series that included a virtual visit from the author and Biblical scholar, Amy-Jill Levine. An Event Planning Calendar of TBC programming is attached to this Report.

TBC remains committed to finding opportunities to partner with other areas of First Community to reach additional audiences with their programming experience. For example, Abbey Jo Griffith and Julie Richards recently co-hosted a multi-session parenting program. Each month TBC receives several names of new interested participants. In addition, new attendees also frequently present themselves as new participants at programs. During a recent book discussion of Glennon Doyle's *Untamed, t*wo participants shared reflectionsthat they didn't know "there were churches like this." This program was their introduction to First Community. It is conceivable that TBC could be the gateway experience for potential members of First Community.

Fundraising for programming continues to be strong, as programs are generally funded by donors who have generously contributed funds directly to support programs. In fact, as a matter of practice, programs are not typically confirmed until at least 40% of the budget has been raised. The Steering Committee has continued its emphasis on financial discipline, and on stewardship and recognition of the donor community. Rose Konrath and Jim Hutchins recently delivered several thank you cards and books to donors who made significant gifts in 2020 which generated many conversations with recipients. There was universal gratitude for David Hett's work, and the freedom David creates to search and share. One person asserted that David Hett "allows people to be and discover who they are."

Much of TBC's organizational meetings and programming have transitioned to virtual and Zoom-enabled formats in the past months. The question of whether and when to return to inperson formats remains open for discussion. Participants report having gotten familiar with much of the convenience and ease provided by virtual formats. The current discussion has focused on finding ways to re-introduce in person programs with a virtual component so that new attendees from afar are retained. The *Much Matters* book discussion now has a regular participant from London, England. With an aim to improve volunteer effectiveness, the Steering Committee has continued ongoing efforts to provide for more orientation and training to assist leaders in their roles as program "producers."

Some continuing challenges for The Burkhart Center include the absence of administrative staff support for organizational activities, and the reduction and future limited availability of Rev. David Hett. At a time when David Hett is now half-time, and on his way to retiring at the end of 2023, his guidance and facilitation of programming continues at the same levels as in previous years. The TBC volunteers on TBC Steering Committee, Adult Learning Council, and the Spiritual Searchers are working to support David Hett in programming most important to him during the next 30 months. David Hett, Abbey Jo Griffith, and Rose Konrath met in April with Dr. Glen Miles to address the future of TBC. Ideally, TBC would like to see a new person hired so that she/he could work collaboratively with David Hett for six or more months before his 2023 retirement. TBC has also been evaluating the hiring of a part or full time Administrator or Director in the near term.

The Burkhart Center continues as a valuable and growing part of First Community, offering a unique set of programs and services to members of First Community and many others. What is needed is a First Community commitment to match the interest and commitment of volunteer leaders and participants. The largest challenge for TBC is that the current circumstance will entail a long-lasting limitation of the programming of The Burkhart Center in a time when commitment to self-generated programming has experienced interest and surging growth.

# Why make changes?

First Community's recently adopted Statement of Financial Values covenants:

One Church, One Budget

"Our operating budgets and financial strategies and reporting are all-inclusive, capturing the totality of the church's activities (revenues & expenses) in support of maximum transparency and effective prioritization and decision making"

Donor intent

"Our systems accurately track donor restrictions, and our spending fully reflects the intent of our donors"

• Financial Responsibility

"While we're committed to living within our means and are responsible stewards of the church's resources, we also aspire to and plan for growth and greater service to our congregation and the community"

# Why make changes?

Putting our Financial Values into practice

Adherence to Generally Accepted Accounting Principles (GAAP)

Adopting best practices

Simplify the accounting functions

Improve our financial reporting by having all activity in the operating accounts

Accountability for all financial resources managed

# Currently

### Operating

Recognizes revenue and expenses

Subject to budgetary controls

Reports operating activity only

### Donor Designated (Restricted)

Recognizes revenue and expenses

Not subject to budgetary controls

Reports change in donor designated activity only

Donor restrictions are loosely defined and controlled by staff

# Effective July 1st

## Operating

Recognizes all revenue and records expenses Subject to budgetary controls

Reports all activity of First Community other than capital campaigns

### Donor Restricted (Designated)

Repository for all donor restricted contributions

Releases contribution to Operating once restriction is met

Restrictions are based on donor intent and must be in writing

Plan is in place to fully fund all donor designated contributions

# When is it appropriate to designate monies as donor restricted?

When a donor restricts a gift to First Community for a <u>specific</u> purpose (use) or <u>when</u> it can be used (time).

First Community makes a written ask that is restricted by use or time and donors make a gift in response.

Best practice is always to get a gift intent in writing. Especially if the donor is being very specific.
